UWL Football 7 on 7 Passing League Rules:

1) Format and Scoring:

a) Each team gets 2 sets of 6 minutes from the 40 yard line on Offense

- i) Completion of 5-14 yards = 1 point
- ii) Completion of 15-39 yards = 2 points
- iii) TD Completion = 3 points

b) Each team gets 1 set of 3 minutes from the 10 yard line on Offense

- i) Completion of 5-9 yards = 2 points
- ii) TD Completion = 3 points

c) Defensive Scoring

- i) PBU (between QB & WR) = 1 point
- ii) Sack (QB doesn't release ball in 4 sec.) = 1 point
- iii) Interception = 2 points

2) Seven-on-seven (Offensive is allowed a Center to snap)

3) One hand touch below the neck.

4) Four seconds to throw the ball.

5) No running plays allowed.

6) All fumbles that touch the ground are dead (offense retains possession).

7) No blocking.

8) **One bump within five yards of the LOS.** Contact that is initiated beyond five yards will result in the loss of 1 point. Absolutely no contact above the shoulders.

9) The ball is dead at the spot of all interceptions and the defense is awarded two points. There is no change of possession. Offense retains possession for remainder of time allotment.

10) All high school football rules apply where needed. Offensive penalties will result in no points for the offensive team. Defensive penalties will result in additional plays at the end of the set.

11) Any flagrant foul can result in disqualification for the game. Repeated violations may cause disqualification for the remainder of the camp.

12) Defensive coaches must stay clear of the secondary during the play, but will be allowed to coach their athletes in between plays as long as they are not hindering the tempo of the drill.

13) Offensive coaches are allowed on the field, behind the play. Each offense will be allowed **ONE HUDDLE ON THE FIELD.** Any team with enough players for multiple huddles must huddle on the sideline between plays with additional huddles. The ball will not be allowed to be snapped, and no points will be awarded on any play until all offensive personnel being substituted for are clear of the field.
